Monday 26th November

- Deadline for Christmas play tickets requests.

Wednesday 12th December

- Christmas play afternoon performance at 2pm. Parents attending the performance may collect their children after the play. Other children are to be collected at the normal time unless booked in to Night Owls. If anyone other than your normal contacts will be collecting your child, please give them the password and notify the School Office.

Thursday 13th December

- Christmas play evening performance at 6pm. Please bring children back to school at 5.45pm dressed in their costume. Due to fire restrictions, please note that only those with tickets will be admitted. **Strictly no younger children.**

Friday 14th December

- Save the Children Christmas Jumper Day – This is a non-uniform day when children may wear festive jumpers to school for a donation to Save the Children.
