Mr Richardson will meet the children at Icknield Walk and stay with them during the rehearsal. **Performance & rehearsal:** Friday 24<sup>th</sup> March at West Road Concert Hall, 11 West Road, Cambridge CB3 9DP

It is also Red Nose Day on 24<sup>th</sup> March, which is a non-uniform day. The year 4 children will need to bring to school a complete school uniform including school shoes and change at lunchtime. As in previous years the children will be picked up by coach from school during the afternoon and have a rehearsal at the concert hall before the performance.
