Coronavirus Update

Dear Parents and Carers,

In order to keep the risk of infection as low as possible for all members of our community, the following decisions and actions are to be put into place this week:

We have decided that we will **not** attend **swimming lessons** which will mean that our sessions have come to a slightly earlier end. The teachers will be planning and teaching an alternative PE session in school to ensure the children still take part in physical activity.

As you already know, the planned **tag rugby festival** has been **cancelled** and the scheduled performance on Friday for **Youth Makes Music** has also now been **cancelled**. The organisers are hopeful that it can be rescheduled at some point in the future.

We also need to limit the number of visitors into school. If you do need to come into school you will be asked to wash your hands or use the hand sanitiser provided. **Early Birds** and **Night Owls** care staff will request that you drop off and pick the children at the main entrance and not come into the main building.

There is **no celebration assembly** planned for this week anyway, it is highly possible though that future assemblies open to the community will be stopped for now.

Unfortunately, we also need to cancel adult visitor attendance at our **Mothers' Day morning**. The children will still create the planned crafts and bring them home.

I am sure that you understand why these decisions have been made. We will of course continue to ensure the children and staff are vigilant in their handwashing and hygiene. We will send you regular updates as needed.
