

Vocabulary	Meaning
Deciduous	A tree or shrub that sheds its leaves annually (every year).
Evergreen	A plant that retains its green leaves all year.
Stem	The main body or stalk of a plant. It usually rises above the ground.
Trunk	The main woody stem of a tree.
Bulb	A rounded underground storage organ present in some plants.
Mature plant	A plant that has been fully developed.

A leaf from a maple tree



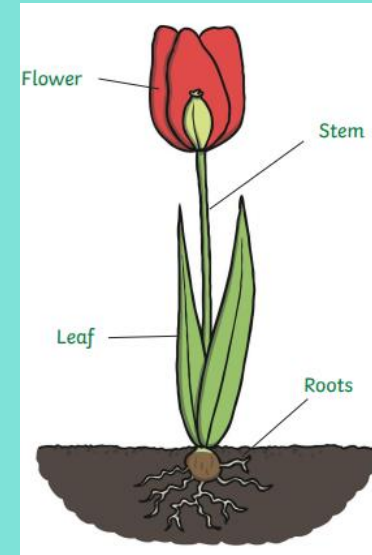
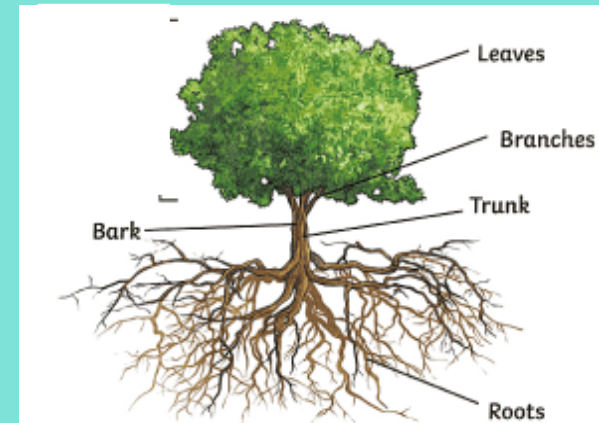
What we will be learning:
