

Living things and their habitats

Vocabulary	Meaning
Habitats	A place where an animal or plant lives. Plants and animals can find all the things they need to survive.
Micro - habitats	A very small, specific habitat for animals and plants.
Food chain	Is a diagram that shows us how animals are linked by what they eat.
Predator	An animal that eats other animals.
Prey	Animals that are hunted for food by other animals.

Sticky Knowledge:
 Some habitats can be large such as an ocean and some can be much smaller for example under a log.
 Minibeasts (such as worms, woodlice, ants, and snails) can be found in micro-habitats.
 Things can be categorised as either living, dead, or never been alive.

A living thing is something that is alive.



A dead thing has once been alive.



A non-living thing has never been alive.
