

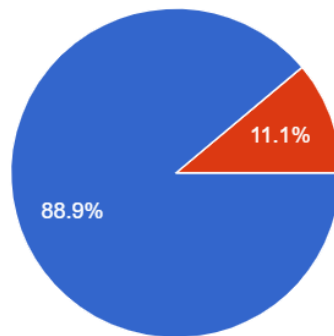

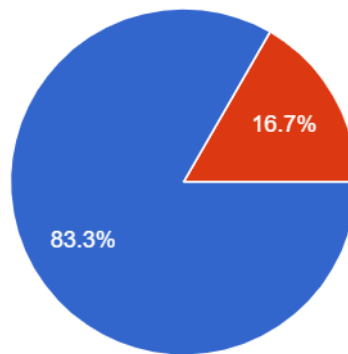

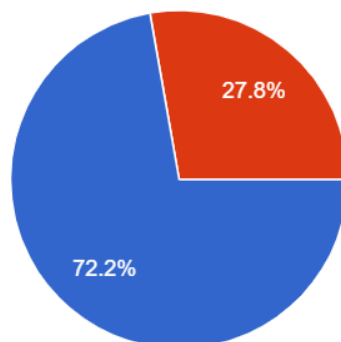

2. My child feels safe at this school.



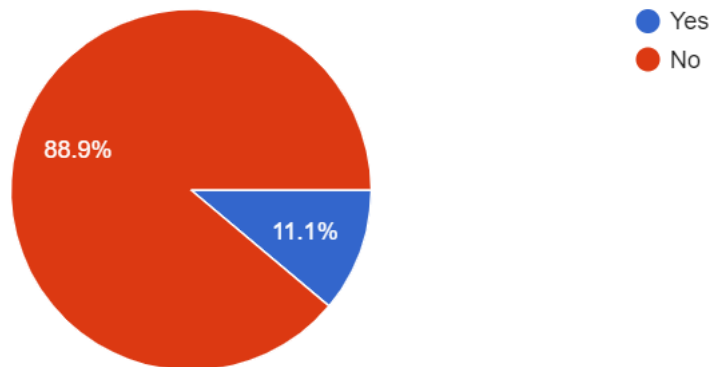

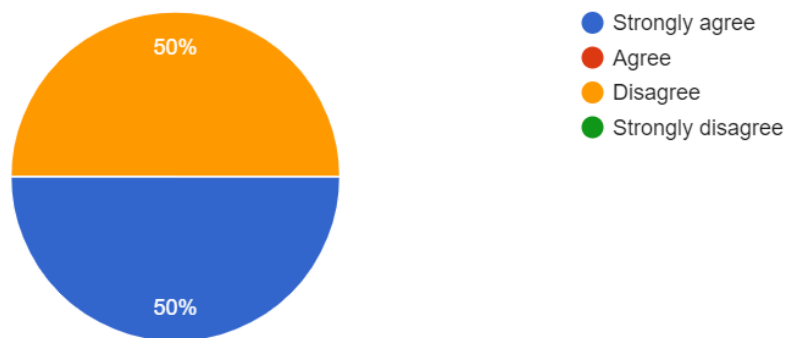

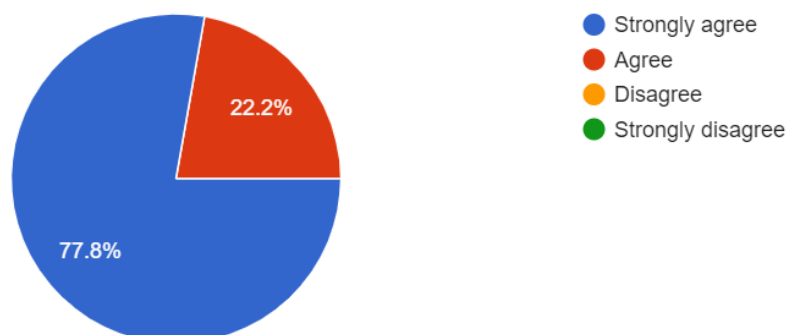

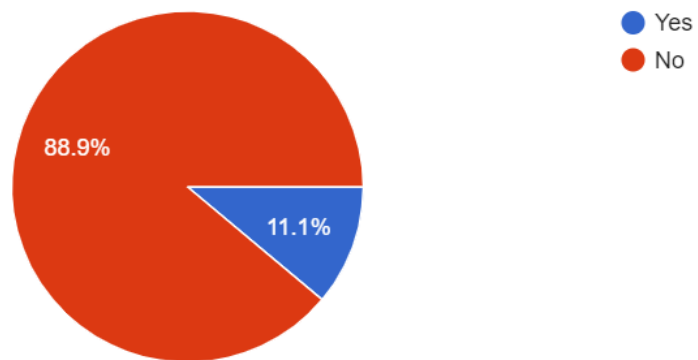

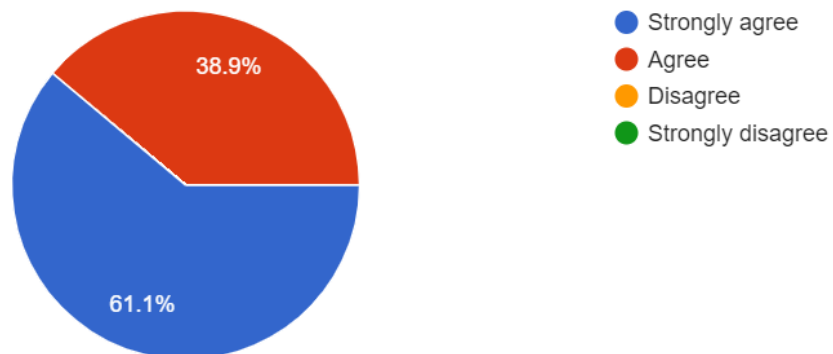

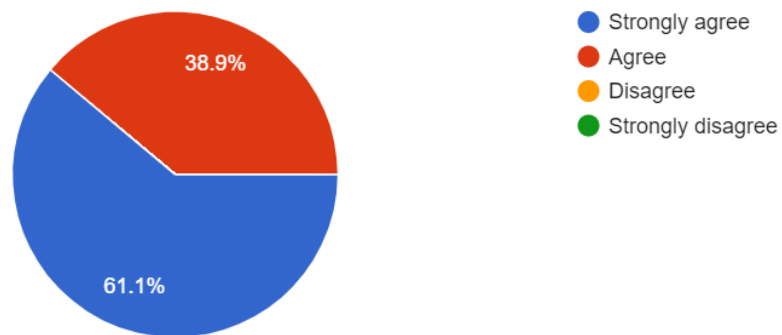
9. My child does well at this school.



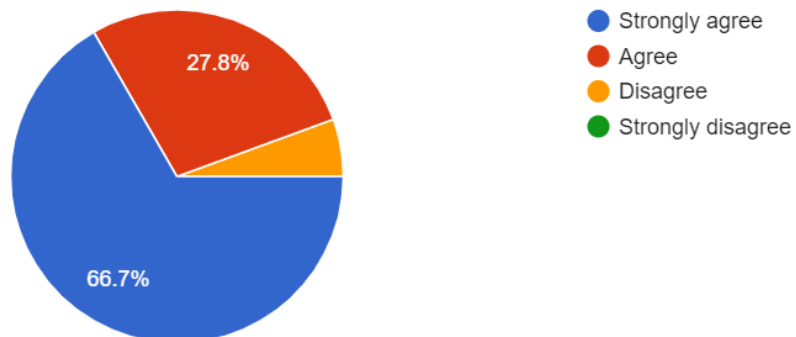
10. The school lets me know how my child is doing.



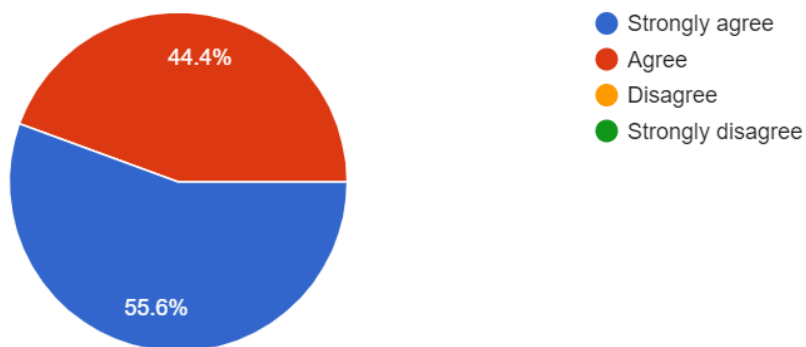

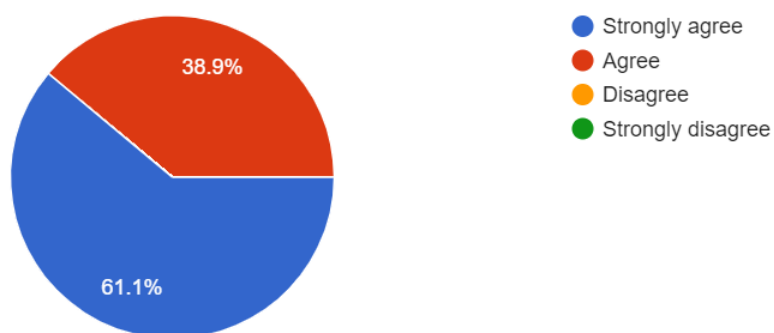

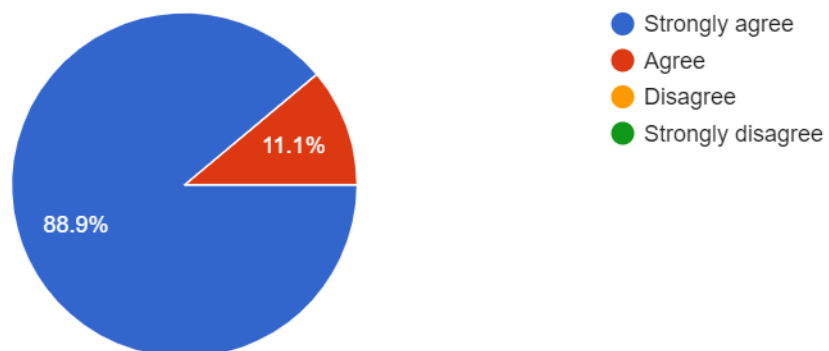
