	Trees we can find in Reed: Oak, Beech, Sycamore	Wild plant - A plant that will grow by itself. It does not need to be cared for.
		Seed - A part of a flowering plant that can develop into a mature plant.
		Germination - When the conditions are right, the seed soaks up water and swells, and the tiny new plant bursts out of its shell. This is called germination.
		Sprout - When a plant sprouts, it grows new shoots. Shoot
A shoot grows upwards from the seed or plant to find sunlight.		
Seed dispersal - is when the seeds move away from the parent plant.
